1. WHAT HAPPENED?

There have been a number of breaches in confined space procedures and incidents on IW site where emergency arrangements where not in place prior to entry.

- March 2019 Operative entered confined space without appropriate rescue equipment.
- April 2019 Operative entered a 3.5m deep tank without the necessary confined space training ticket or the relevant permit to work checklist completed.
- May 2019 Operative entered approximately 2.2M deep manhole without adequate training or appropriate rescue equipment.

2. IMMEDIATE ACTIONS

In all incidents works were ceased until a safe system of work was implemented.

3. ACTIONS/ RECOMMENDATIONS

- Ensure all operatives are aware at induction training that only specialised trained operatives are permitted access into confined spaces.
- Ensure operatives are made aware of confined space locations.
- Ensure a location specific rescue plan is communicated and understood by all involved with confined space entry.
- Ensure all rescue equipment is in place and adequately inspected prior to use.
