

Notice of proposed project pursuant to Regulation 42(13) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 (S.I. No. 477 of 2011), as amended.

I. The location, nature and extent of the proposed project

The location, nature and extent of proposed project are as follows; proposed desilting activity at Clogh Castlecomer Water Treatment Plant, Loan, Co. Kilkenny.
