May have been a weight. 2.23cm x 1.85cm x 0.23cm.</p> <p>Piece of led with irregular circular outline – may have the remains of an iron nail at the centre. 3.7cm x 3.65 cm x 0.36cm.</p> <p>Large, cast bronze buckle, missing its pin. The outer edge is shaped in a series of curves. The inner edge is square. 6.52cm x 6.7cm.</p>
